THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A POLICE AUTHORITY ADMINISTRATIVE EXCELLENCE AWARD

Background

This report updates Members with regard to progress on the introduction of a Police Authority Administrative Excellence Award.

RECOMMENDED: That the report be noted.

Detail

Members proposed the introduction of a Police Authority Administrative Excellence Award to be presented annually to either a department, section or individual within the Constabulary considered to be particularly deserving of such an award. An initial draft proposal, prepared by Mr Moth, has been submitted to the Chief Constable for comment. Unfortunately due to other competing pressures, such as PASAIF and, more recently, the Home Secretary's announcement of a review of force structures, it has not been possible to take this particular piece of work any further forward. Members should be aware that it is unlikely that it will be possible to give this matter any priority over the next few months but a report will be submitted to the Committee as soon as is possible in 2006
